

Materials Suggested List for INTERIOR as SELF-DISCOVERY: Part One

Drawing Materials:

A few of sheets of Stonehenge Paper or Rives BFK (a bit more expensive but takes the charcoal better), approximately 200 lb., 22x30in.

Masking Tape

Vine Charcoal – different sizes are good, medium density is good

Drawing Board (large enough for the paper)

Chamois (deer skin)

Kneaded Eraser

Painting Materials:

Palette (at least 11"x14")

Tall can, to hold your brushes that are in use (like large V-8 juice can)

Gamsol

Linseed Oil

Any other painting media you like to use (optional)

Baby food jar or similar with lid (to hold your painting medium if you mix
Gamsol and linseed oil)

Palette knife (with blade long like a finger)

Palette cup (metal with a clip on the bottom)

Cotton rags (Important!)

A variety of brushes.

Oil Paint:

Titanium White

Black, Mars or Ivory

Ultramarine Blue

Burnt Sienna

Acrylic Paint:

Titanium White

Black, Mars or Ivory

Canvases: at least two – maybe three, in size no smaller than 16" on one side and no larger than 30" on the other.
