## Materials List for Painting Through Modern Masters – Cezanne/Matisse/Diebenkorn

Palette (at least 11"x14") (non-disposable: wood preferred) Tall can to hold brushes that are in use (like large V-8 juice can) **Gamsol** Linseed Oil Stand Oil (optional) Liquin (optional) Cold Wax medium (optional) Baby food jar or similar with lid Palette knife (with blade long like a finger) Palette cup (metal with a clip on the bottom) Cotton rags (Important!)

A variety of brushes, I recommend hog bristle by Signet/Robert Simmons (try different shapes, there are four kinds: rounds, flats, brights and filberts; you need at least two brights that are a number 10, two brights that are a number 8, three brights that are a number 6 and three brights that are a number 4. You might also bring in some larger brushes – 1-2 inches wide.

Suggested colors: Titanium White (large tube) Ivory black or mars black Cadmium Red Light Cadmium Red Medium Quinacridone Red Alizarin Crimson Permanent Cadmium Yellow Light Indian Yellow Cadmium Yellow Medium Ultramarine Blue **Prussian Blue** And anything else – Phtalo Green Cobalth Green Dioxazine Purple Cadmium Orange

Canvas: two (2) anywhere in the range of 16"x20" to 20"x24", and three (3) small ones, approximately 9"x12" to 12"x16".
